CCC Action Steps During the Awareness Phase

The awareness phase of the 2020 Census officially starts in January 2020 and extends through February 2020

- Government and community leaders throughout the nation participate in activities highlighting the message that the 2020 Census is easy, important, and safe.
- Hold regular CCC and subcommittee meetings
- Finalize plans for activities surrounding responding to the Census
- Review task lists and subcommittee plans





More CCC Action Steps During the Awareness Phase

- Proceed with 2020 Census activities
- Finalize plans for activities to encourage residents to complete and respond to the Census
- Develop and finalize plans for motivating residents who do not participate to cooperate with census takers during nonresponse follow-up




Strategy for working with Hard-to-Count Populations

- Use consistent, clear messaging
- Include American and foreign-born residents, youth and elderly residents
- Utilize existing **partnerships** with community leaders and organizations (civic, social, religious, etc.)
- Reach out to **property managers** at apartment homes and group quarters (PCHs, shelters, etc.)
- Reach out to our **transient population** like extended stays, motels, etc.






Mapping Tools – 2020 Census Low Response Tracts








Mapping Tools – Response Outreach Area Mapper (ROAM) and County Integrated Map

What We Have Done

- Equipped cities with media toolkit
- Partnered with public schools to send Census information home via students
- Partnered with multiple entities
- Set up joint county-city events
- Awarded one and applying for a second grant for the CCC





Community Outreach Plans – Census Day Events

Based on 2020 Census Key Dates for Data Collection Operations, Clayton County is:

- Proposing 3-4 Census Day events in March 2020 across the county
- Working with our cities for multiple events to be held on April 1, 2020 across the county
- Set up in-person meeting discussions
- Providing awareness at regular community event through the county
- Engaging business owners to become sponsors and allow post cards to be distributed at their business locations
- Setting locations strategically around Low Response Areas and centralized
 government offices


